

Welcome to Siblyback Lake

Siblyback Lake on Bodmin Moor lies within the Cornwall Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. It is a water supply reservoir owned by South West Water and is managed by South West Lakes Trust for public access and recreation. Dammed in 1960, this 140 acre lake supplies East Cornwall and beyond and is a popular location for a variety of activities.

Walking & Cycling
The circular trail around the lake is suitable for pushchairs, wheelchairs and cycling. It is 5km (3.1 miles) long and encloses a range of habitats typical of the moorland environment. Please cycle in an anti-clockwise direction.
For visitors with less mobility we have a 'rampers' mobility scooter available to hire from reception.



Recreation
Our Outdoor + Active Centre caters for a full range of activities both on and off the water. Please call into reception to find out more.



Wildlife
At the northern end of the lake you will find a bird hide nestled amongst the trees and overlooking the water. Siblyback is home to a variety of wildlife which you may see as you explore the area.



Facilities
Our cafe serves seasonal food all year round and offers a variety of hot and cold drinks, delicious cakes and local ice cream. Enjoy our children's play area and off-road cycle challenge area.



Dogs Welcome
Dogs are most welcome but must be kept on a lead and out of the water. Please pick up after your dog to help us provide a clean environment for all visitors.



Trout Angling
A popular trout fishery, angling is available Mid-March to late October. Siblyback is a 'best of the Best' Water and has been a Commercially Fly Fishing Championship Venue. Permits available to purchase on site.
